Toowoomba Wellcamp Airport has seen significant increased demand for air freight and will continue supporting our customers and the region in the timely movement of essential goods and other general aviation activities.

The Qantas Group Pilot Academy will continue to operate as normal.

Toowoomba Wellcamp Airport is working alongside Qantas and Air North during these uncertain times to provide support and assistance where needed.

We look forward to the re-instatement of services as soon as practicable in the circumstances.
